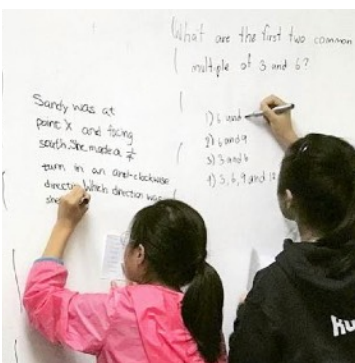
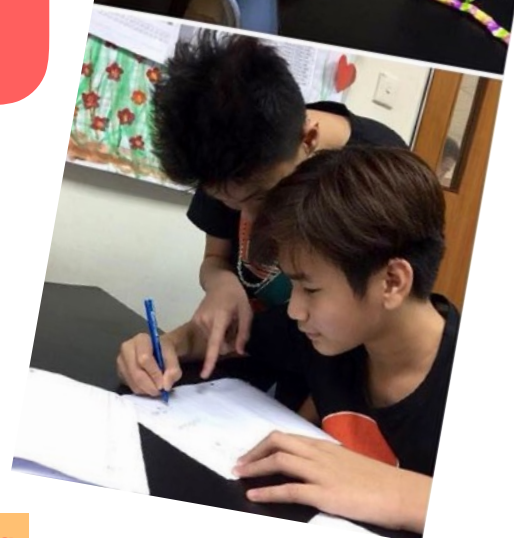


Work-shop style revision for 'O' Level

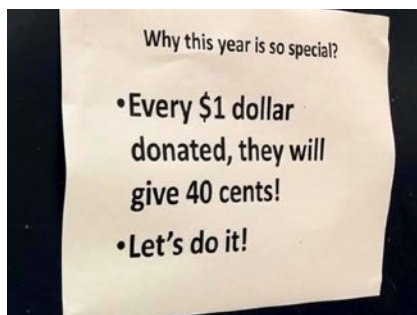
Lions
